



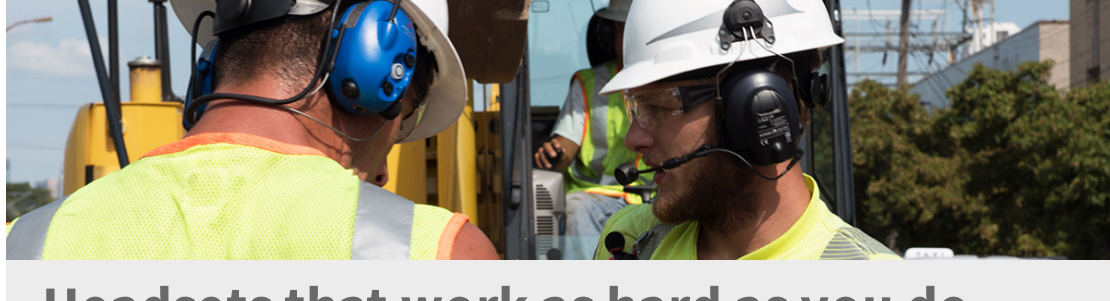

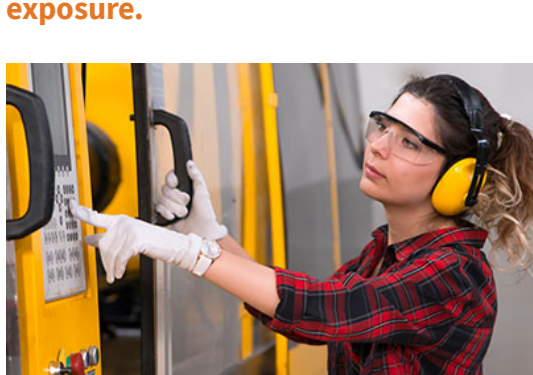
**EHS Managed Services****Elevated Noise and Hearing Conservation**

Hearing loss is a major hazard in many workplaces. Approximately 30 million American workers are exposed to noise levels at their job that can damage their hearing, and the Bureau of Labor Statistics reports that over 20,000 employees report occupationally induced hearing loss every year. Excessively loud workplace environments don't just pose a risk to your workers' eardrums; they threaten their overall safety as noisy environments often lead to workplace incidents, loss of communication, a decrease in productivity and lost time accidents.

OSHA's Occupational Noise Exposure regulation 29 CFR 1910.95 requires any employer with noise exposure over 85db (decibels) to implement a hearing conservation program. And any employee exposed to elevated noise over 90db for an 8-hour TWA is required to have hearing protection, or hearing protection put into place by the employer to reduce the noise exposure. This OSHA requirement includes monitoring for noise hazards, implementing a written program, conducting hearing assessment and testing of employees, and conducting annual training along with providing proper PPE.
